Description of the project:

The Smart Card device was used for the registration of electors within the election process. It was meant for identification of individuals and consequently for issuing an electronic permit (stored on the Smart Card medium) to take part in the elections.

A person, firstly having the identity checked and verified in the database of electors, which was stored in the H41 terminal, was then issued a permit to vote.

Specific software application used during the process, which did not allow for any other functionality except for the pre-defined procedure, was developed by the customer especially for this purpose.
